


Youth Consultation Group

Terms and Conditions

We are recruiting for more young people aged 12-18 to join our Youth Consultation Group.

Applications will be accepted from 9am Thursday August 23 until 5pm Friday 14 September 2018. Our website has details of how to apply: www.sciencefestival.co.uk/youth-consultation-group

We welcome applications from in and around Edinburgh. Most of the activity will be based at the Science Festival HQ, by the Shore in Leith. Some events and activities may take place at other venues around Edinburgh. Edinburgh International Science Festival will support successful participants with travel costs to and from Science Festival HQ and other venues associated with events.

By submitting an application to the Youth Consultation Group you are indicating your acceptance of the following terms and conditions. Please read them carefully.


The Youth Consultation Group is an Edinburgh International Science Festival project. Registered address 110 Commercial Street, Edinburgh, EH6 6NF. Registered Charity No. SC003790.

1. By submitting an application to take part in the Youth Consultation Group you are confirming that you will be aged no younger than 12 years and no older than 18 years on the 14 September 2018.
2. No purchase of tickets for other Science Festival events is necessary in order to apply to participate in the Youth Consultation Group.
3. Only one application will be accepted per person.
4. The application process will be open from 9am Thursday August 23 until 5pm Friday 14 September 2018 and the Science Festival reserves the right to amend the application process closing date at any time.
5. Sending an e-mail, text or WhatsApp is not proof that we have received your entry. No responsibility can be accepted for entries that are lost or delayed, or which are not received for any reason.
6. If you are under 13 years old at the time of applying you confirm you will not contact Edinburgh International Science Festival via social media as the social media pages the organisation uses have an age limit of 13 years old.
7. Successful applicants will be chosen by an advisory panel. The panel will be comprised of members of the Science Festival team and expert consultants. The selection will be made according to the diversity of ages, gender and interests required by the project.
8. The Science Festival will endeavour to inform successful applicants by 28 September 2018.
9. If you are selected to take part in the Youth Consultation Group, we will notify you via the method of contact through which we received your application. The panel's decision will be final, and no correspondence will be entered into over the panel's selection decisions.
10. Places on the Youth Consultation Group may not be transferred to another person.
11. If you are offered a place on the Youth Consultation Group, you will need to be able to travel to and available to attend sessions on Fridays between 3.30pm and 5.30pm. You will need to be available to attend at least one session a month.
12. Successful applicants will be responsible for making their own travel arrangements to attend the Youth Consultation Group sessions.
13. The Science Festival will support successful participants' travel costs to and from the venue of each session up to the cost of a day return bus ticket within city limits per participant. This

can be claimed through submission of receipts, totalling no more than £4.50 sterling per day. Reimbursements will be in cash. If you feel that you do not fit within these parameters and travel costs may be a barrier to your participation, please contact us by emailing youth@scifest.co.uk Alternative arrangements may be available.

14. Successful participants have a responsibility to respect cultural differences. All participants should acknowledge the need for responsible behaviour and accept that the Science Festival will make decisions based on the safety of the group as a whole. The Science Festival has the right to exclude young people if their behaviour becomes unacceptable.
15. The Science Festival encourages successful participants to eat lunch prior to any session. The Science Festival will provide successful participants with refreshments at each session. Successful participants will be consulted in advance in order to ensure dietary requirements are taken into account and accommodated wherever possible.
16. If your application to be part of the Youth Consultation Group is successful, you may be required to participate in such promotional activity and material as the Science Festival may require. There are times when we may wish to take photographs or video of participants at the event. These may be used for marketing and promotional purposes.
17. The Science Festivals reserves the right to alter the structure of the Youth Consultation Group experience at any time.
